Method for Filing Applications

Any person wishing to file an application for the purpose of obtaining an Islamic solution to his/her dispute(s), should adhere to the following guidelines:

- I. Complete the attached application form.
(Note: the person filing the complaint is the applicant and the person against whom the complaint is filed is the respondent. Both the applicant as well as the respondent could be more than one individual.)
- II. Thereafter, whilst addressing the Sheikh/Mufti, complete details regarding the dispute should be written.
- III. After elucidating the details of the dispute, the applicant should conclude his/her application by clarifying, in no uncertain terms, as to what he/she demands.
- IV. Finally, the application should be signed and dated.
- V. Although applications may be written in English, Arabic or Urdu, correspondence from the IFTAA DEPARTMENT will only be in English. Translations may be provided upon request.
- VI. Applications may be mailed to the CCMT (refer to letter head for CCMT address) or submitted in person to:

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- (Applications being submitted in person must be in a sealed envelope with the applicants name and address on it)
- VII. Applications may also be faxed to IFTAA DEPARTMENT at (416) 981-3247.
- VIII. An administration fee of \$200 dollars must be submitted with the application. The fee may be paid in cash or cheque payable to Canadian Council of Muslim Theologians. A receipt will be issued on reception of the above mentioned fees.
- IX. A letter of acknowledgment is attached to these guidelines; the applicant should read it carefully, sign and return it with his/her application.

Important notice:

- **The IFTAA DEPARTMENT is only a religious authority. All civil/legal issues must be referred to the appropriate authorities**
- **Based on the quranic injunction:**

If you fear the couple may separate, then appoint (with their consent) a mediatorif they (the mediators) both desire reconciliation, almighty Allah will create unity between the couple (if this is best for them). Verily Allah is all knowing, informed.
